# 01 The ENTR Library

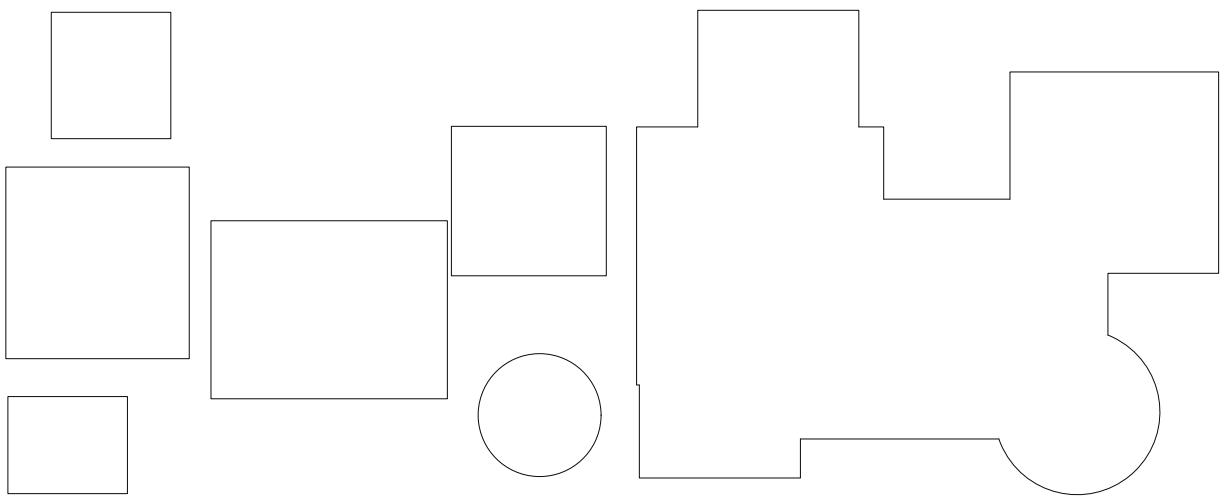

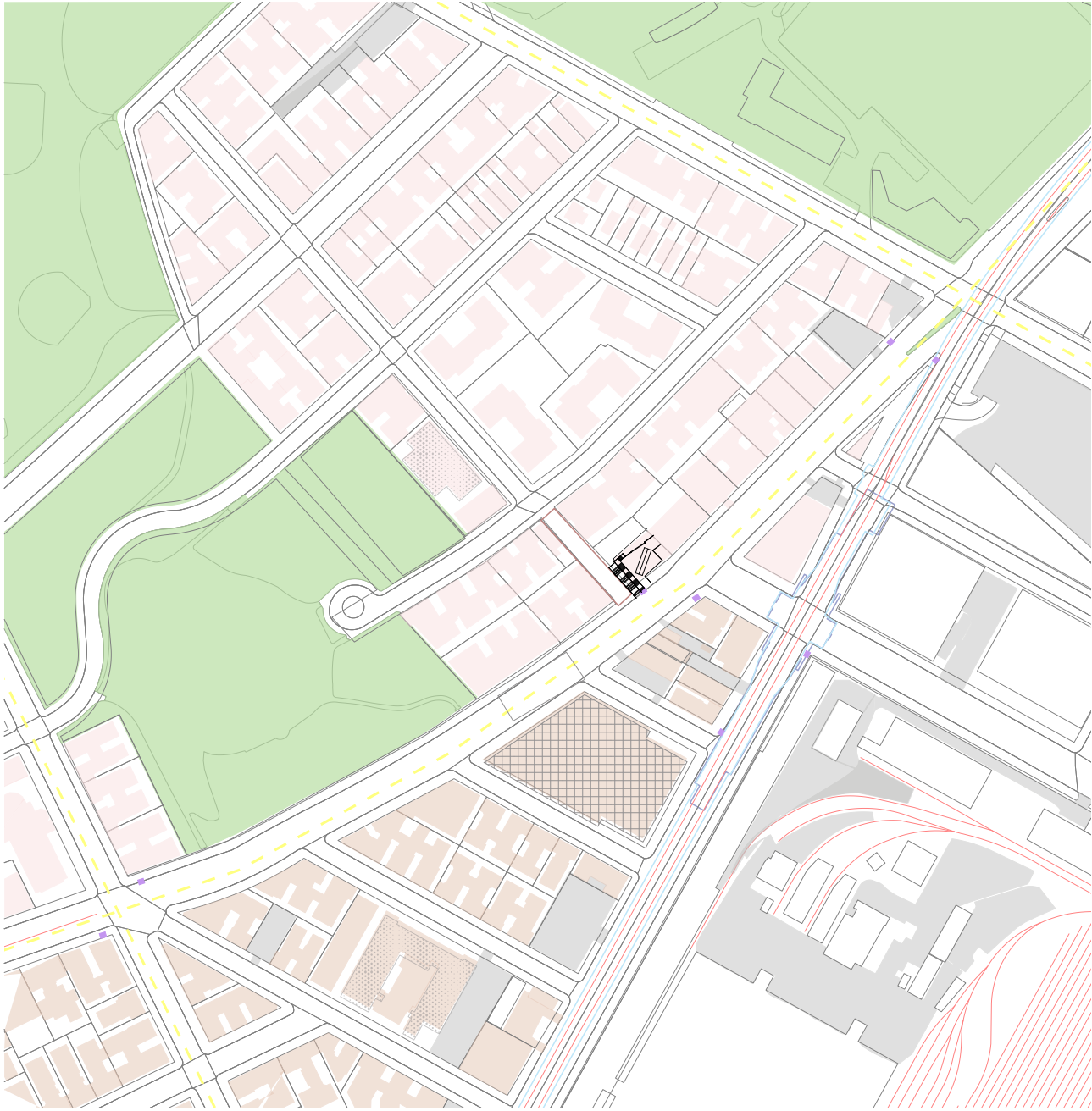




Program Adjacency Diagram



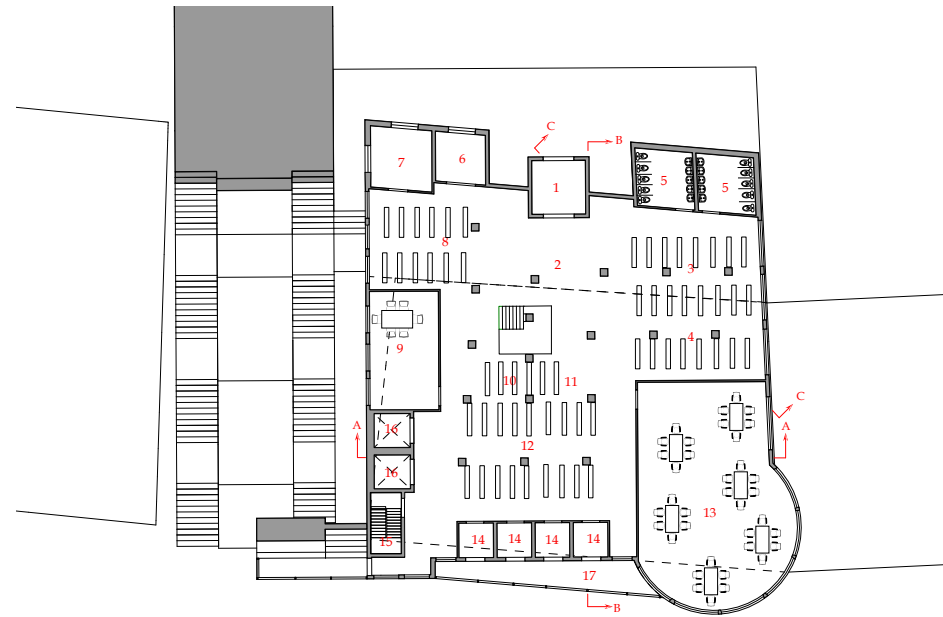
Concept Diagrams

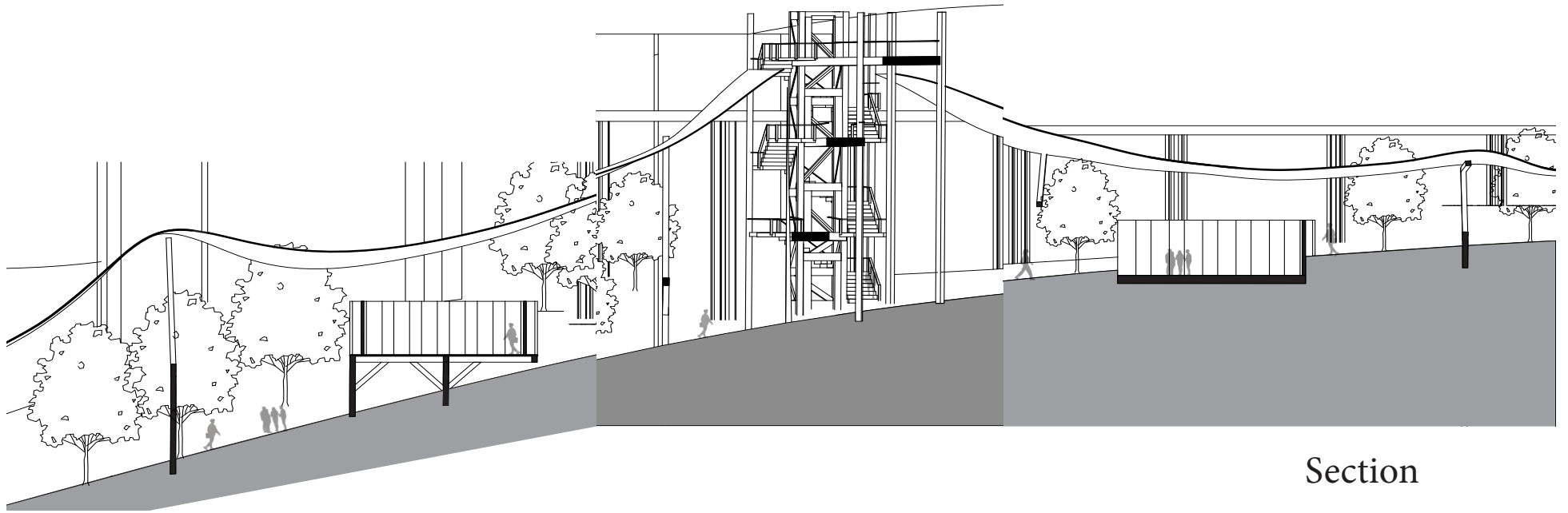


## 02 Kean Skyland Extention

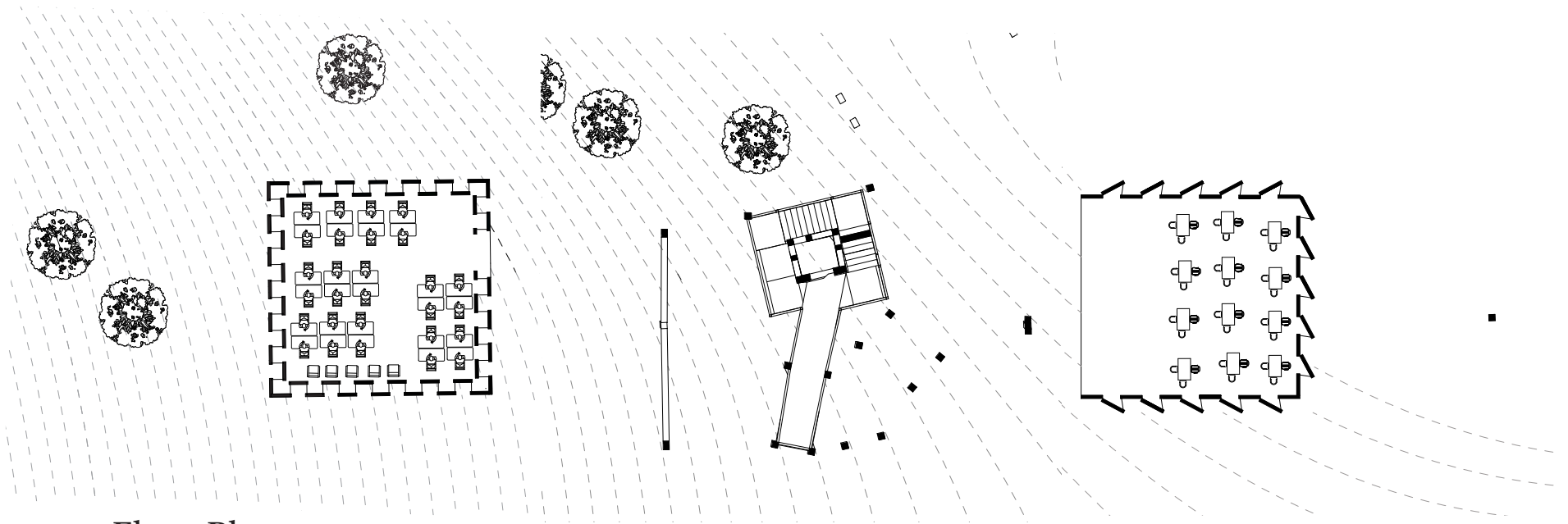

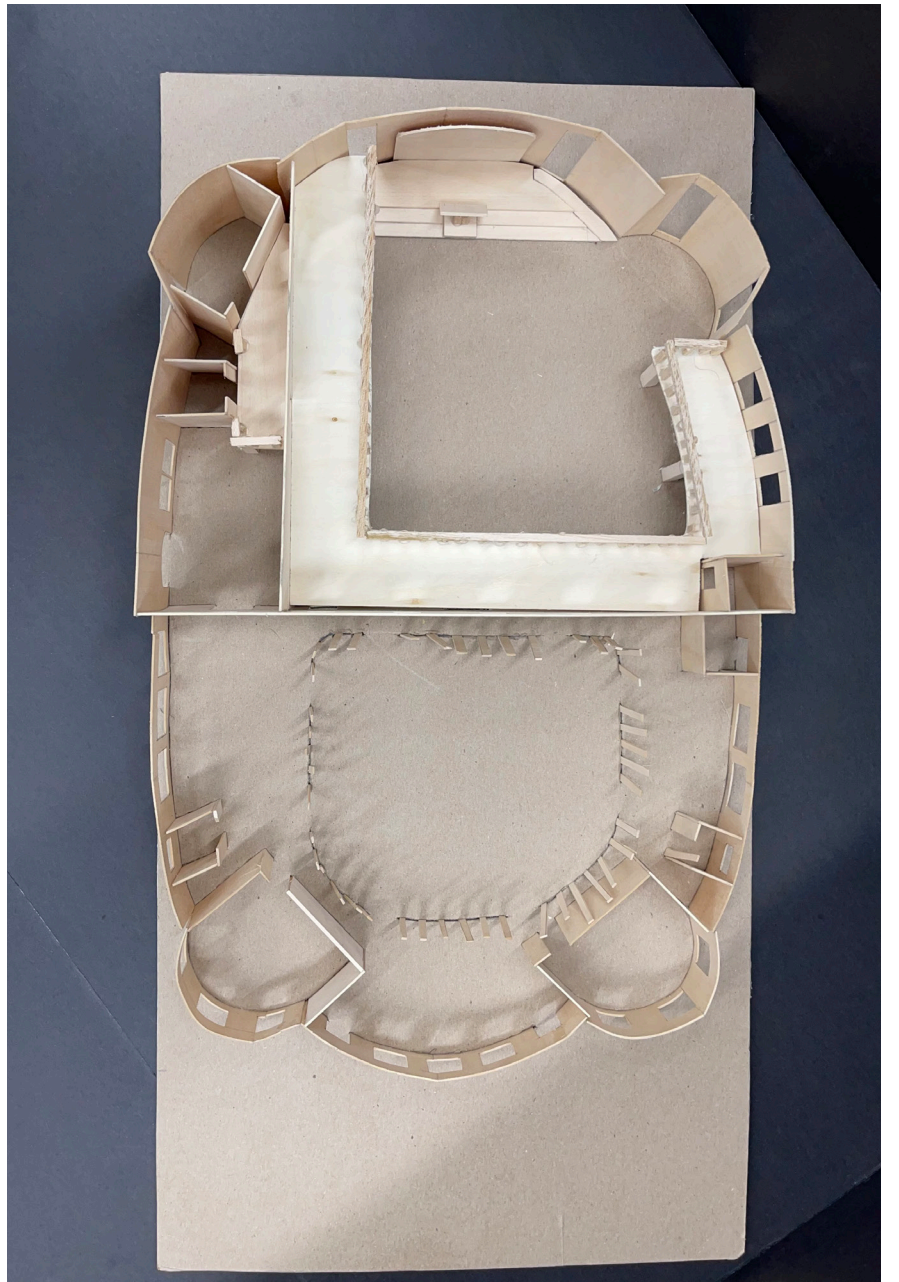
# 03 Synagogue

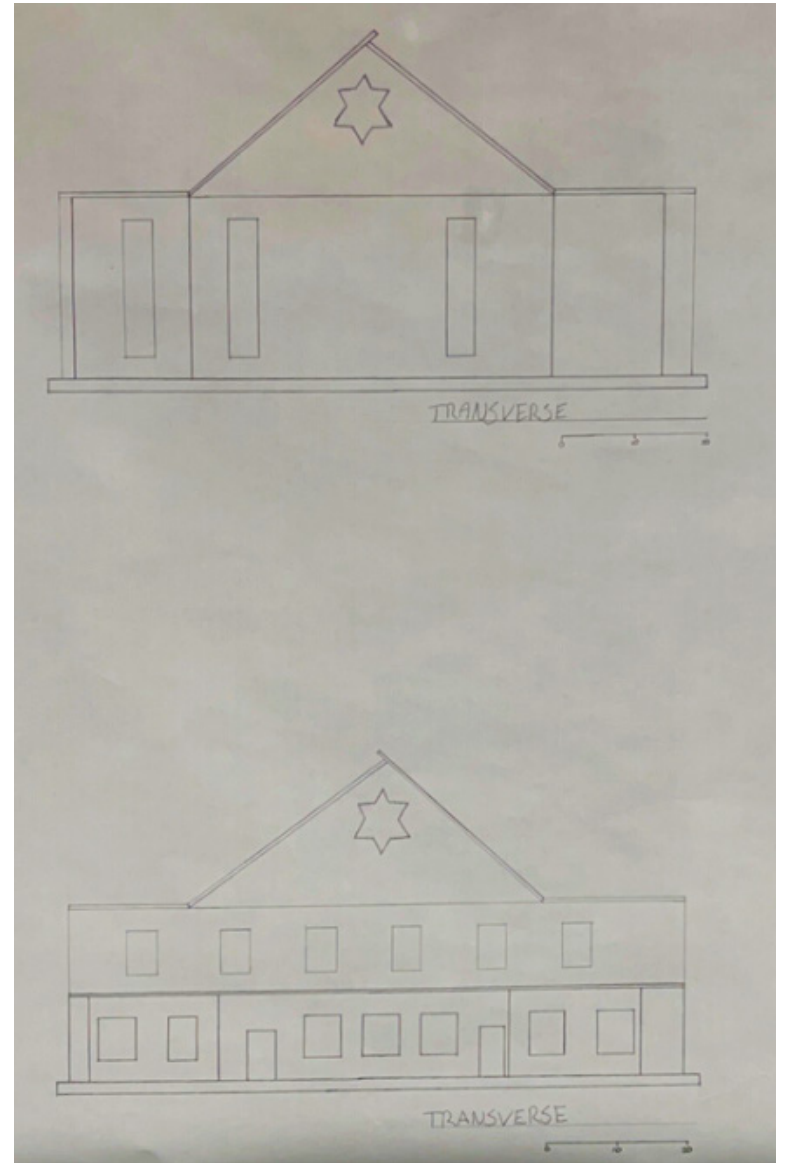
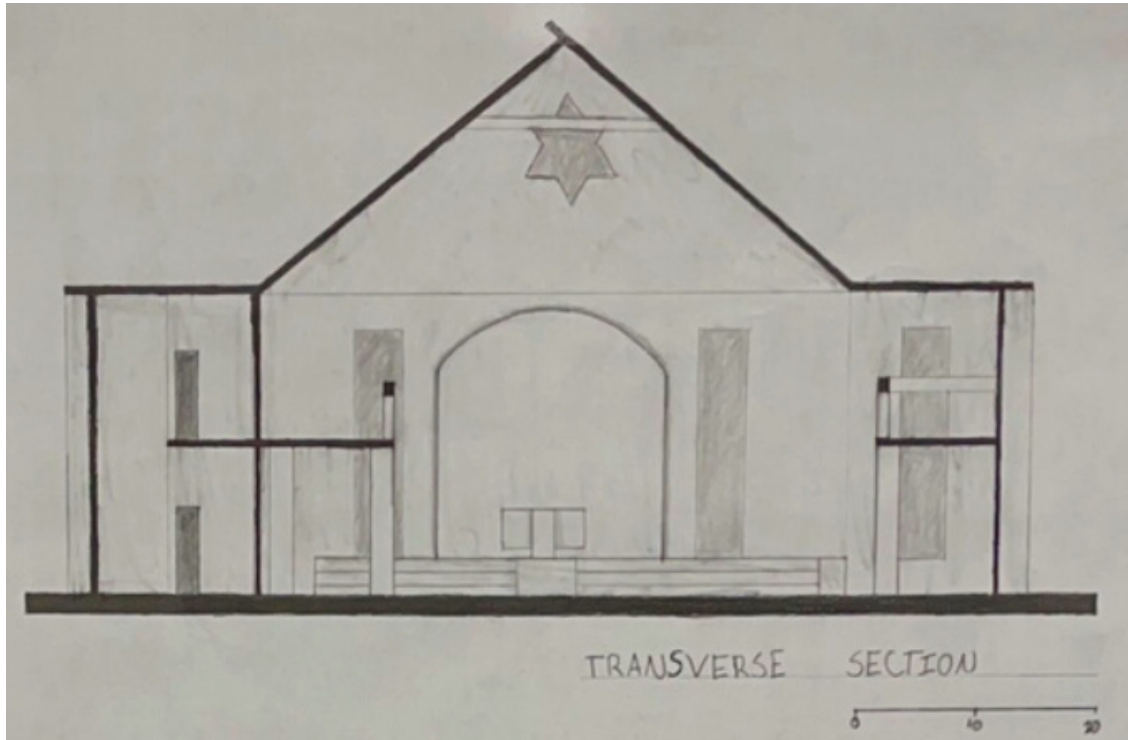
The assignment was to envision and design a new synagogue situated in front of the community commons at the New Jersey Jewish Education and Community Center.





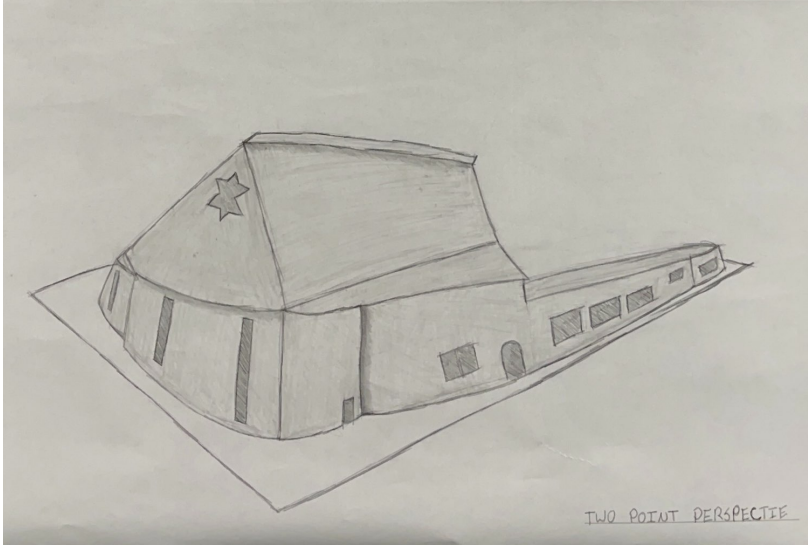




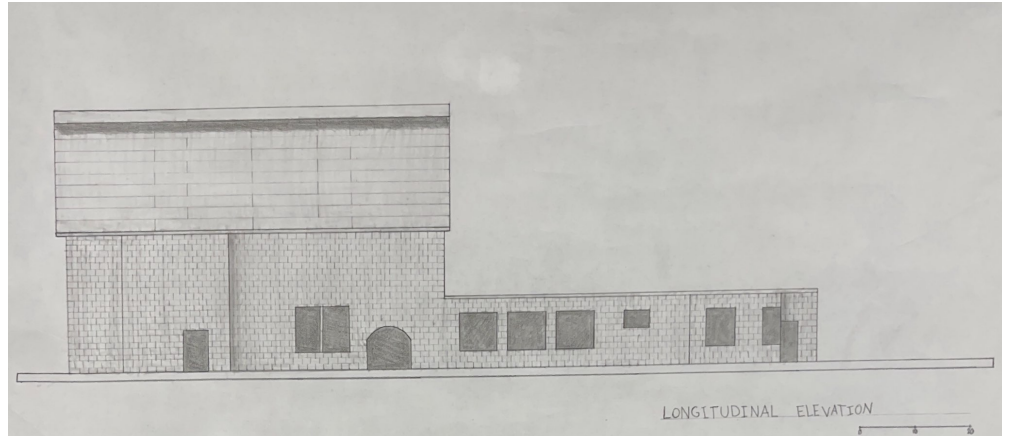




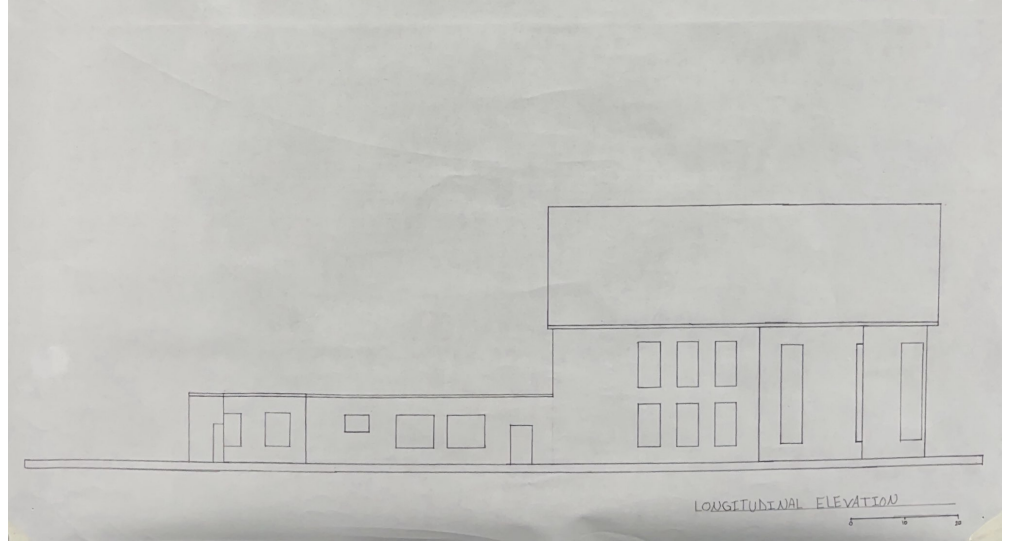

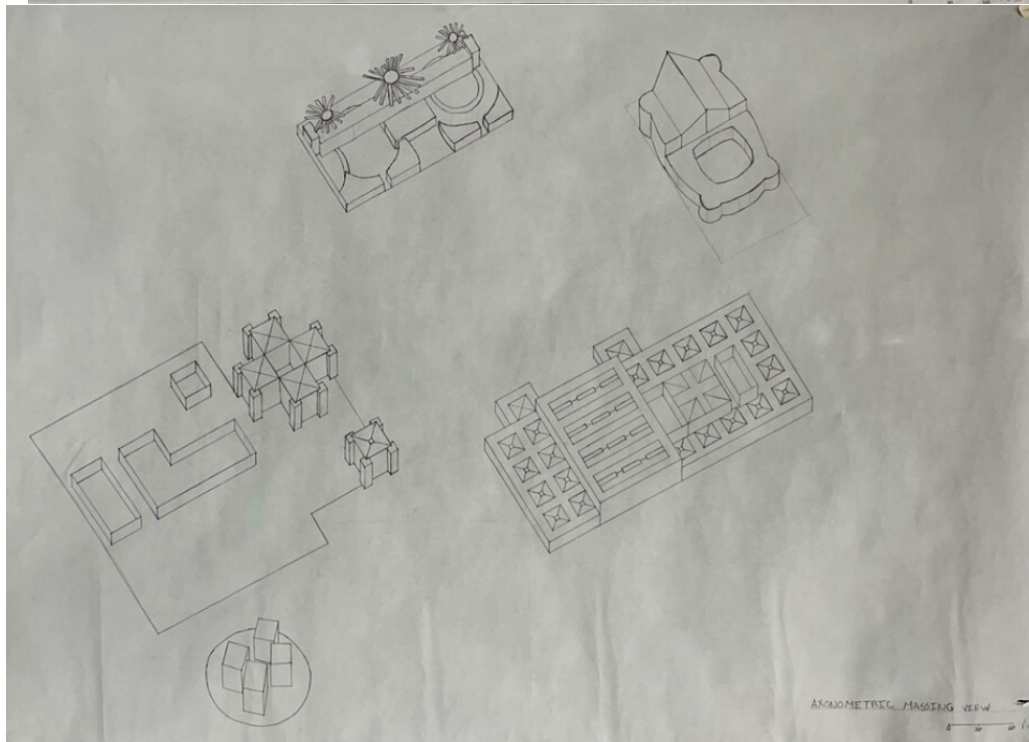
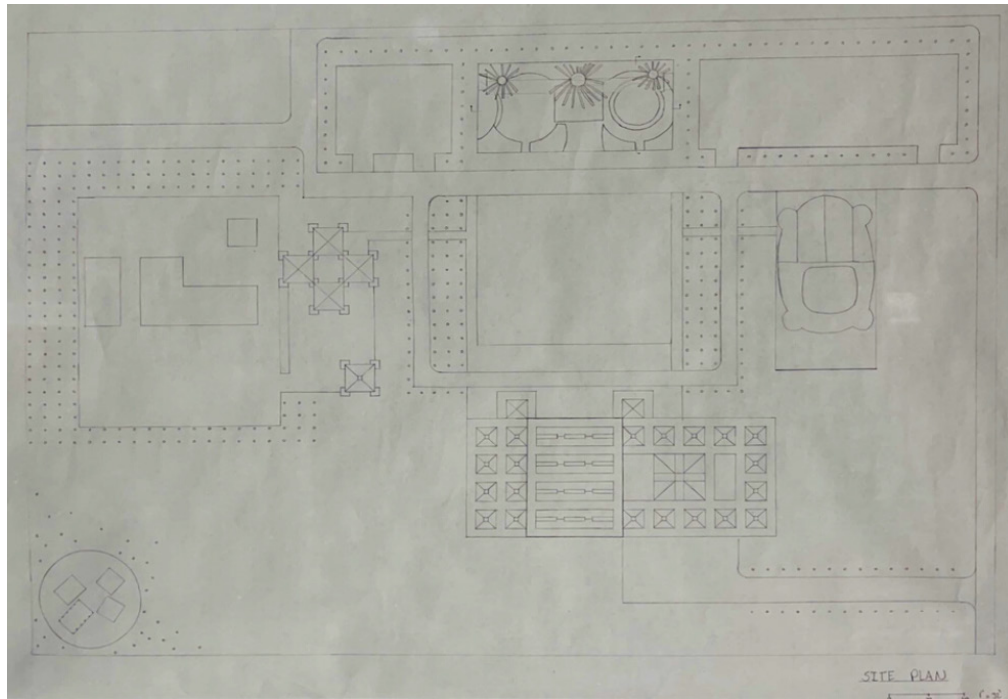
LONGITUDINAL ELEVATION

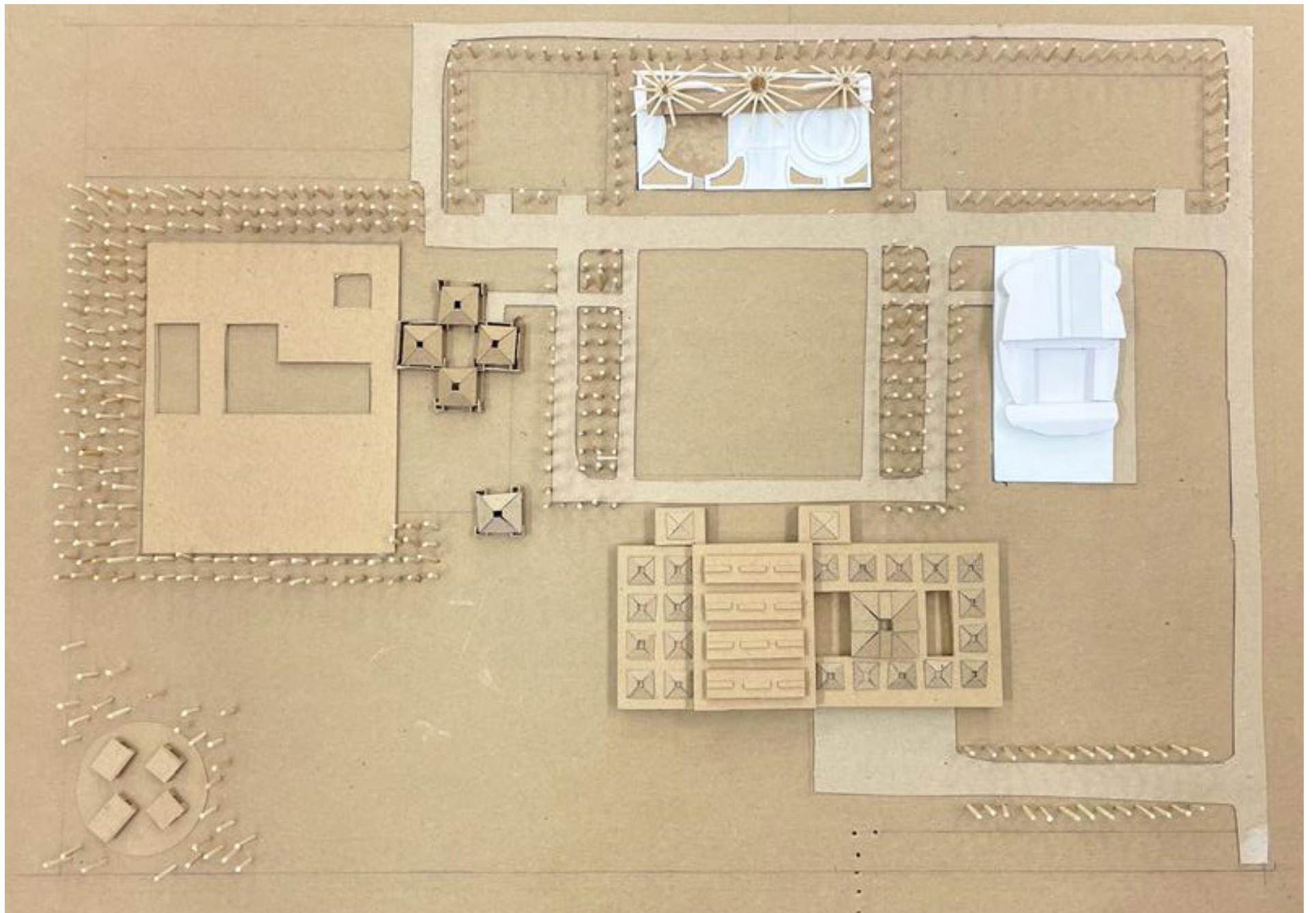

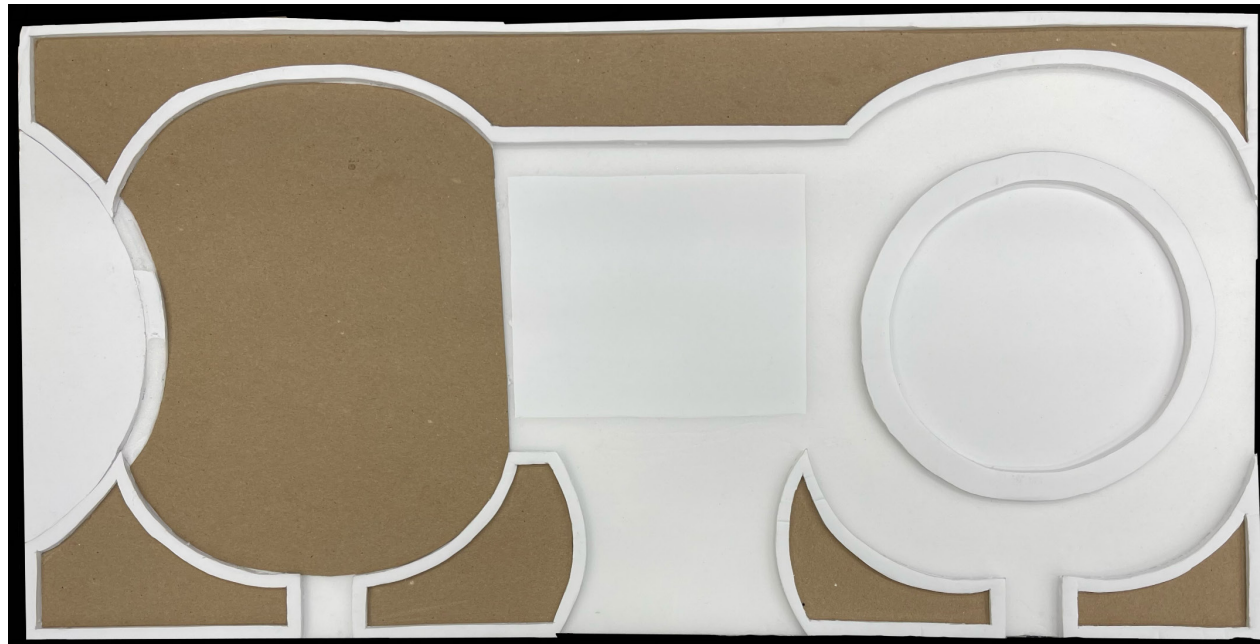

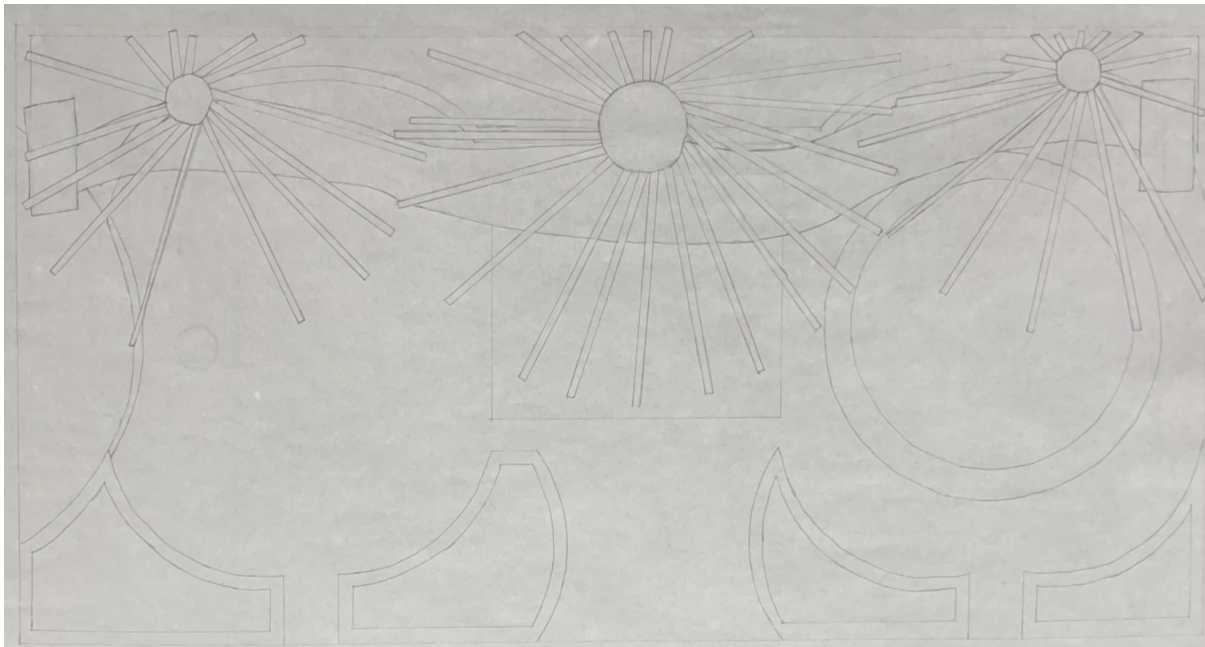


# 04 Brick & Wood Landscape

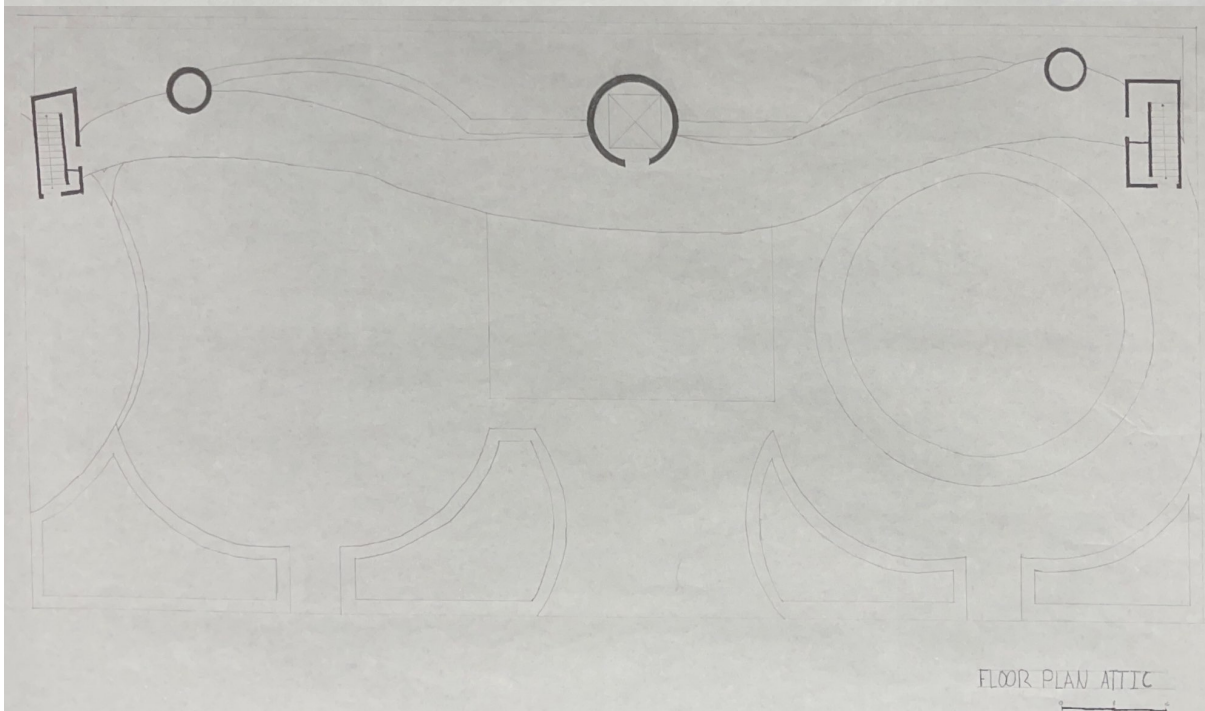
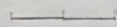

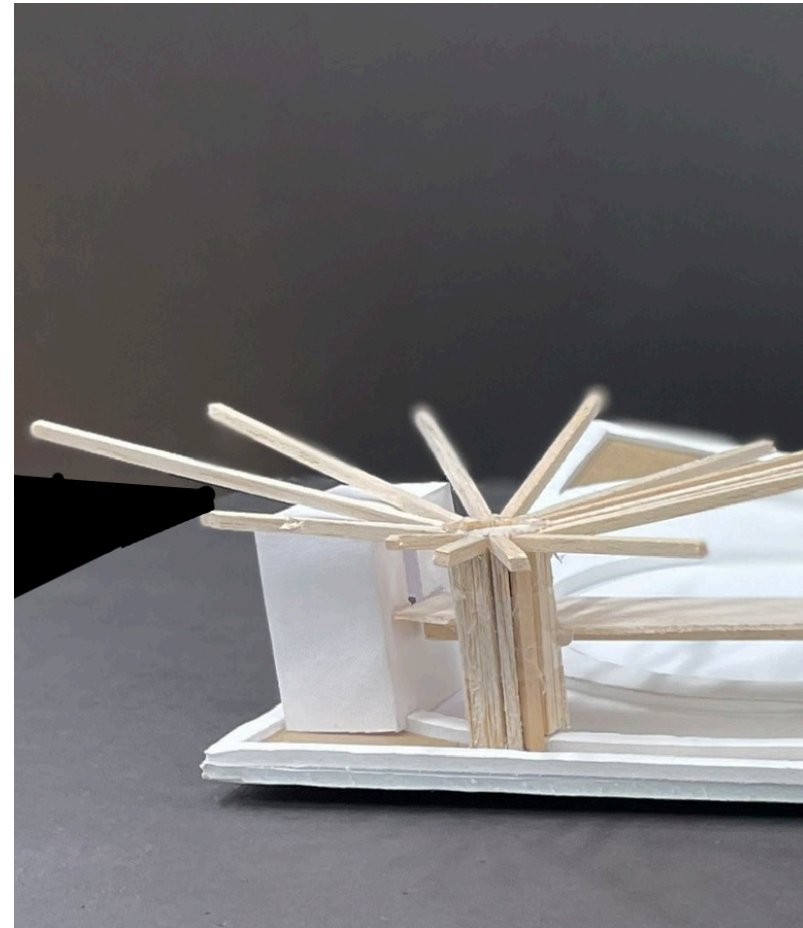
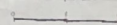


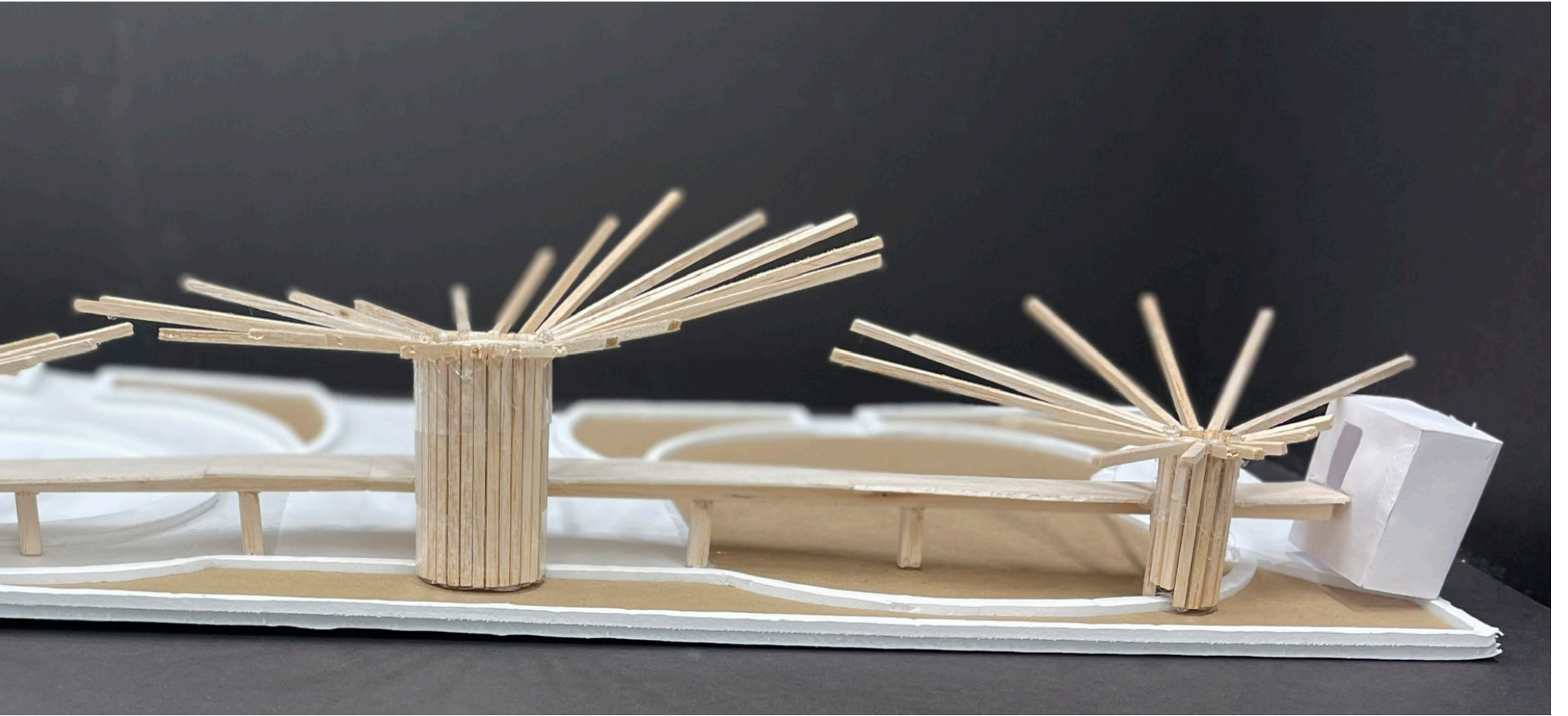


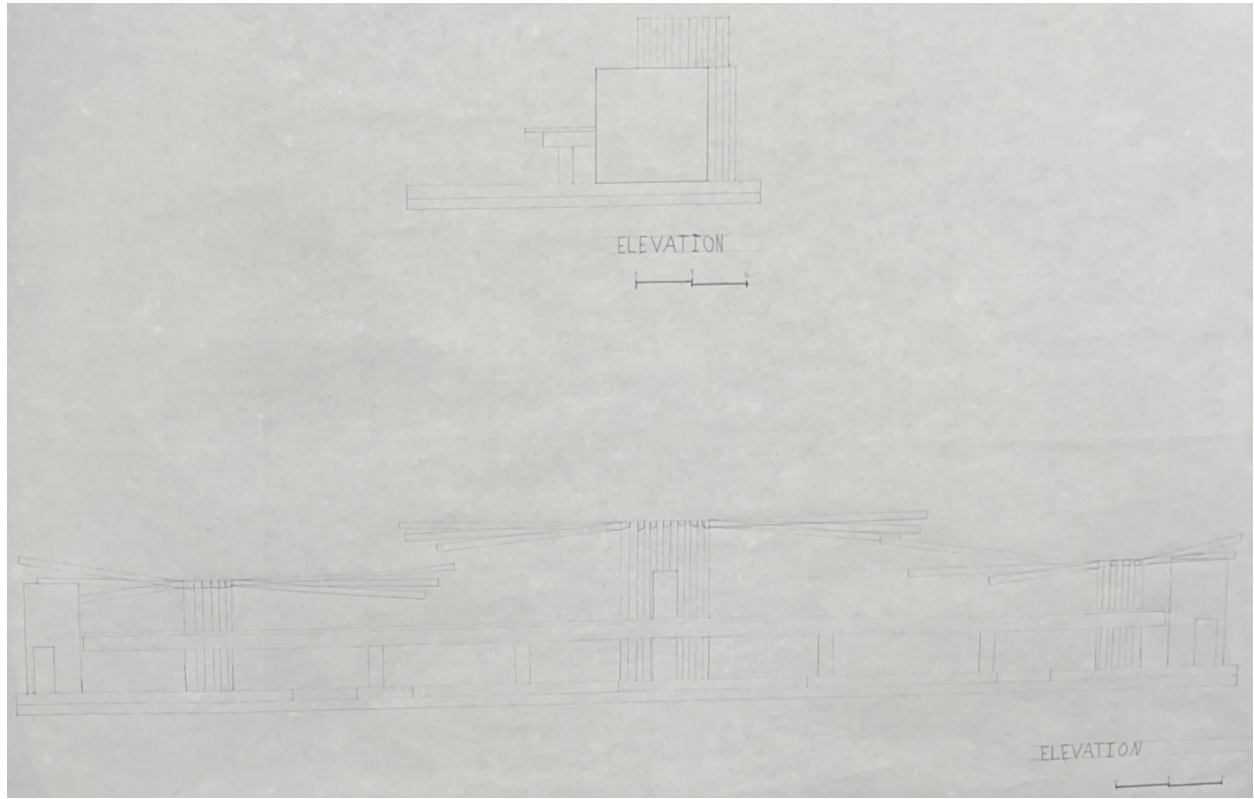
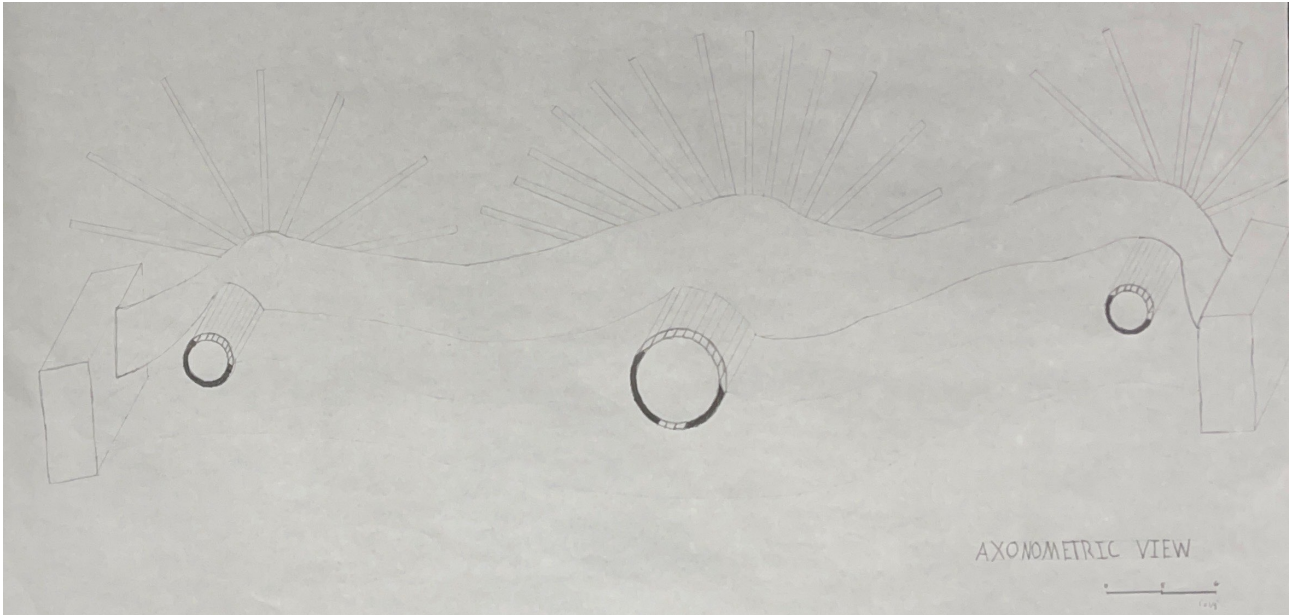
ROOF PLAN

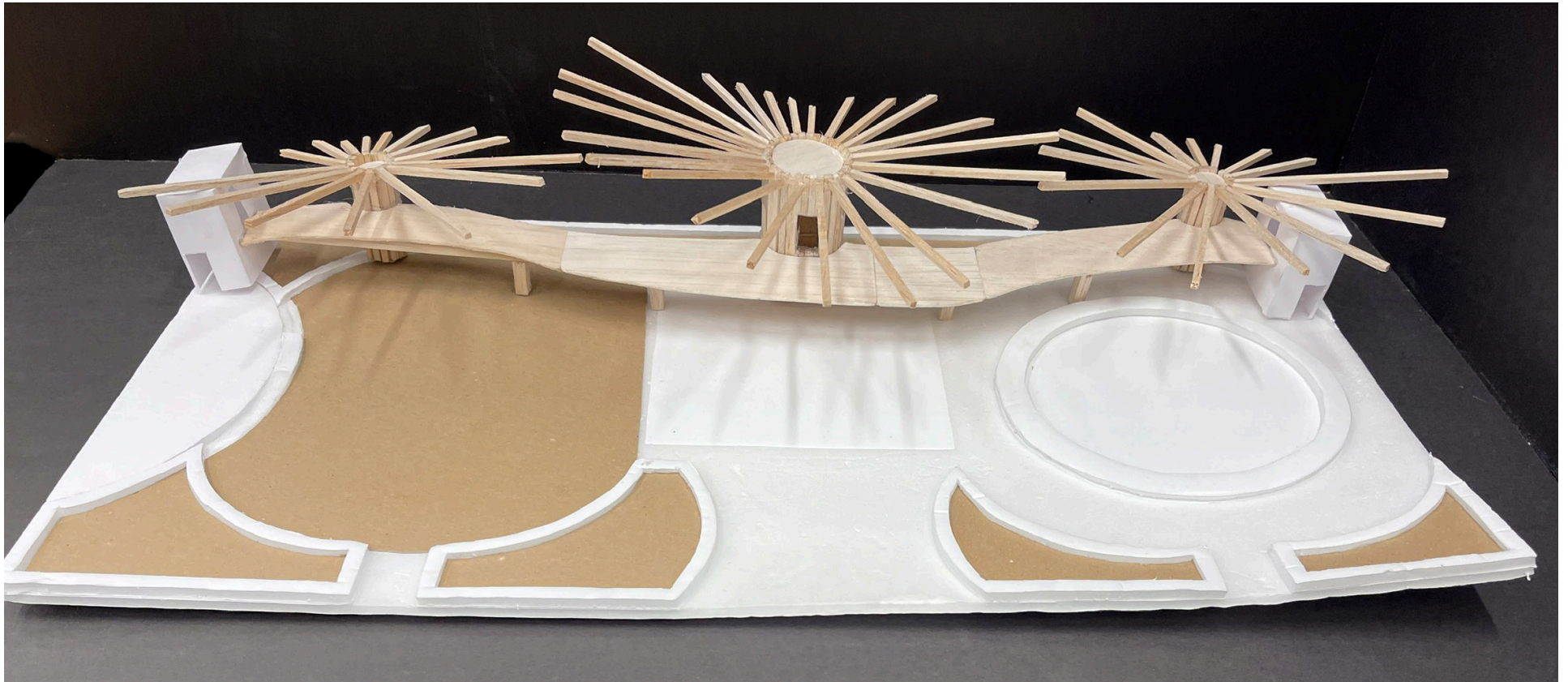


FLOOR PLAN ATTIC





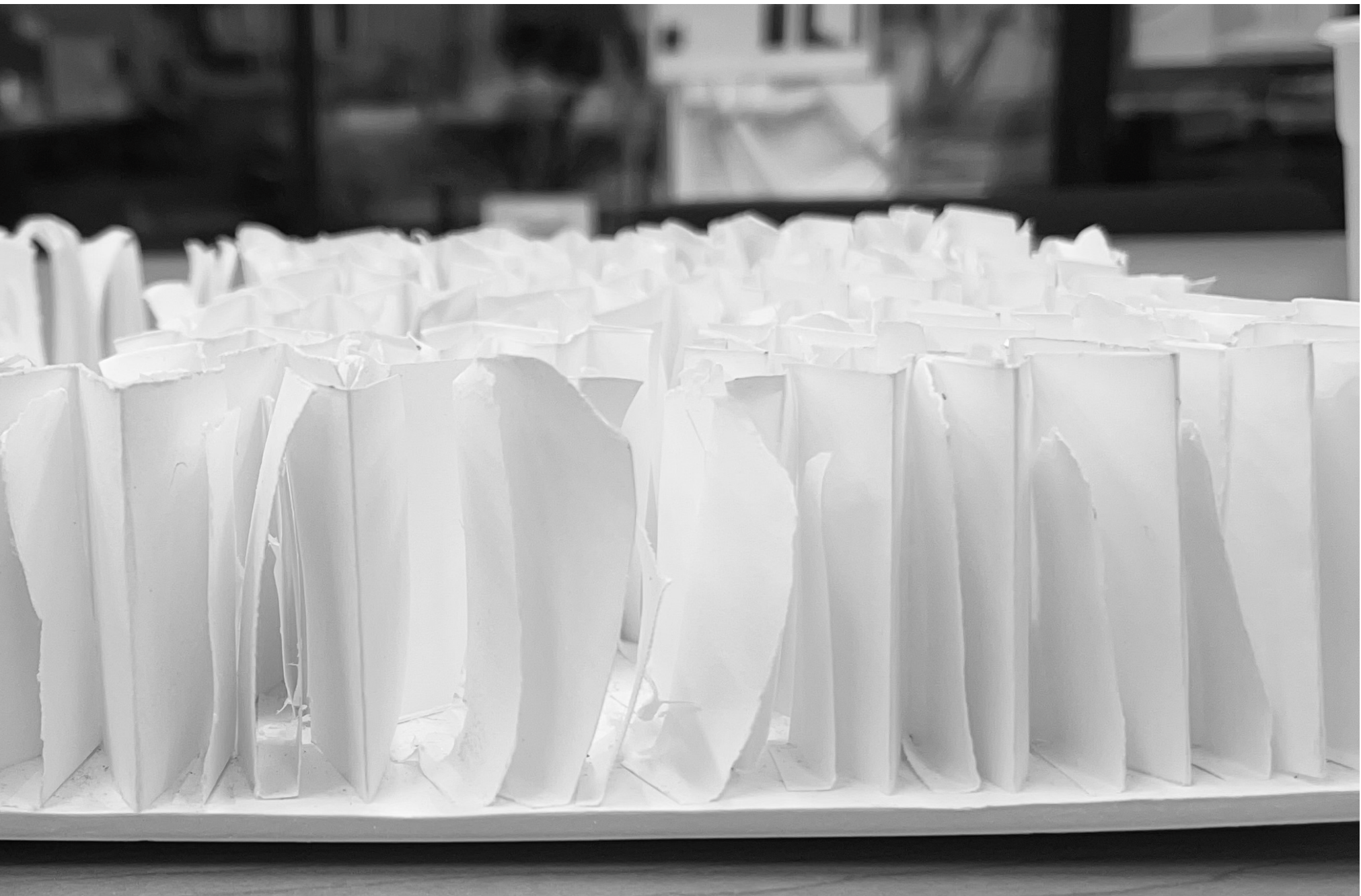




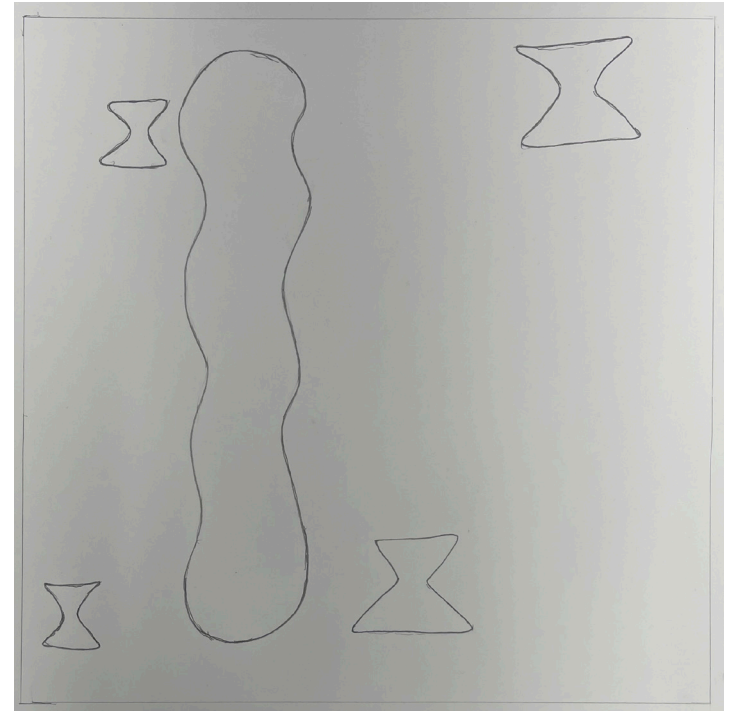
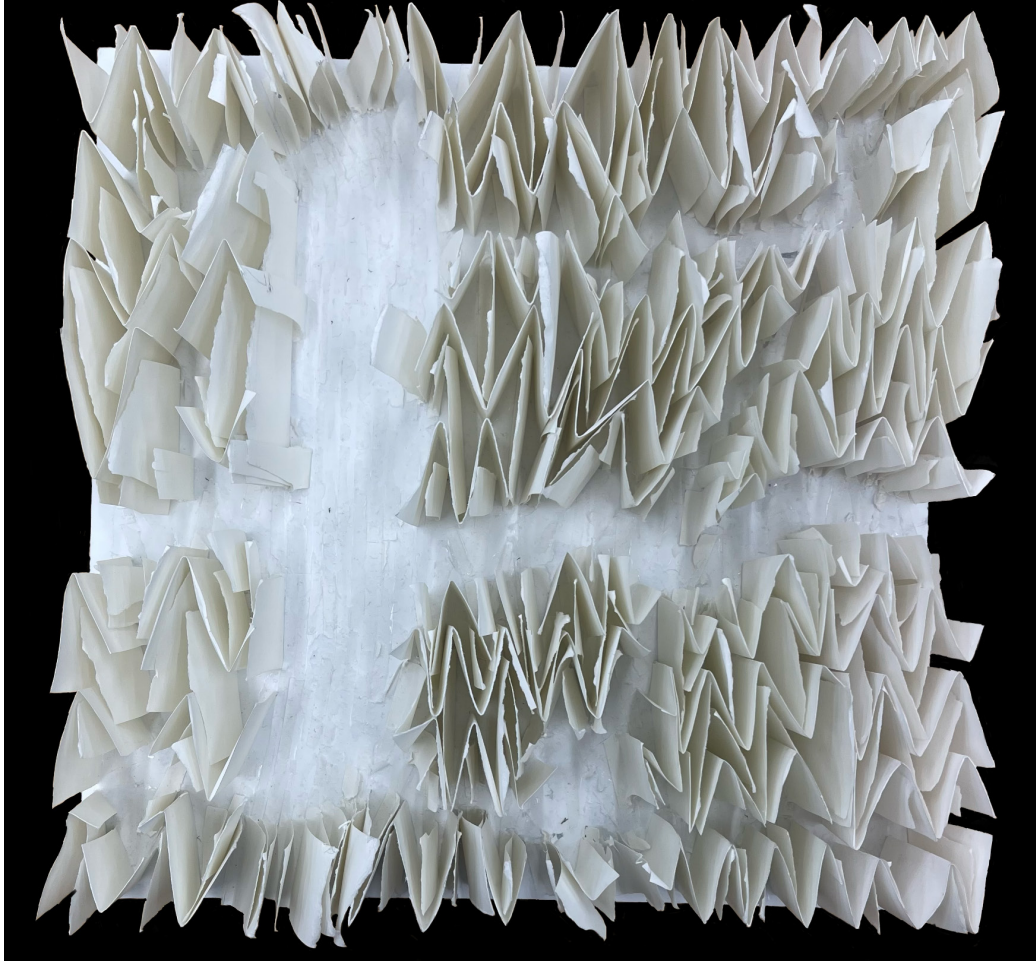
# 05 Density, Space, Street, & Facades

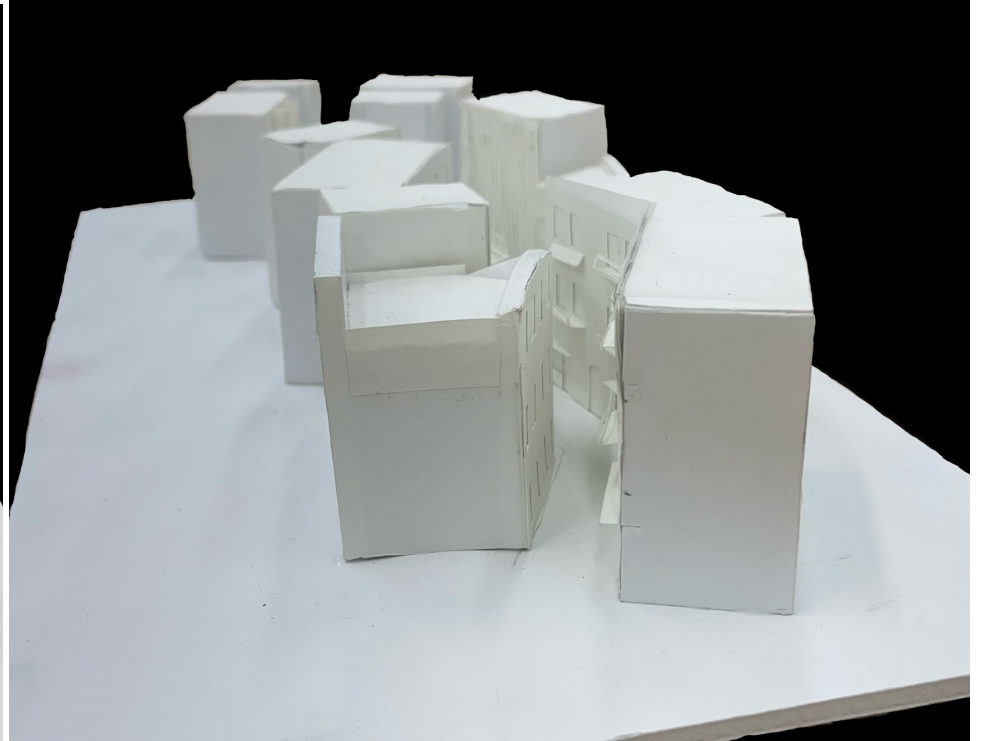
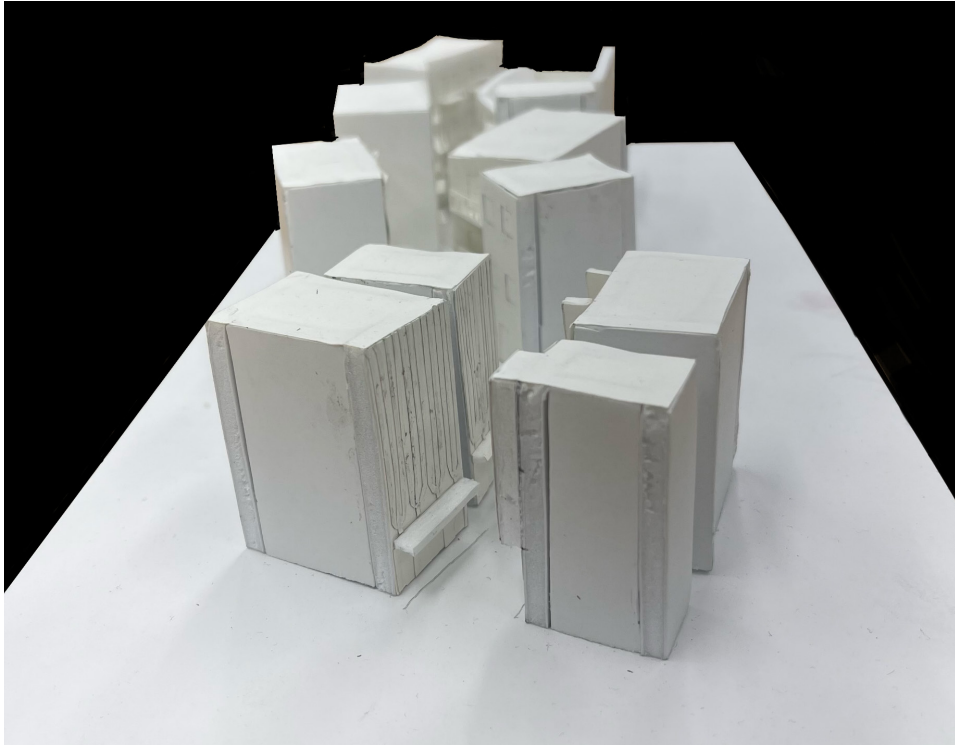

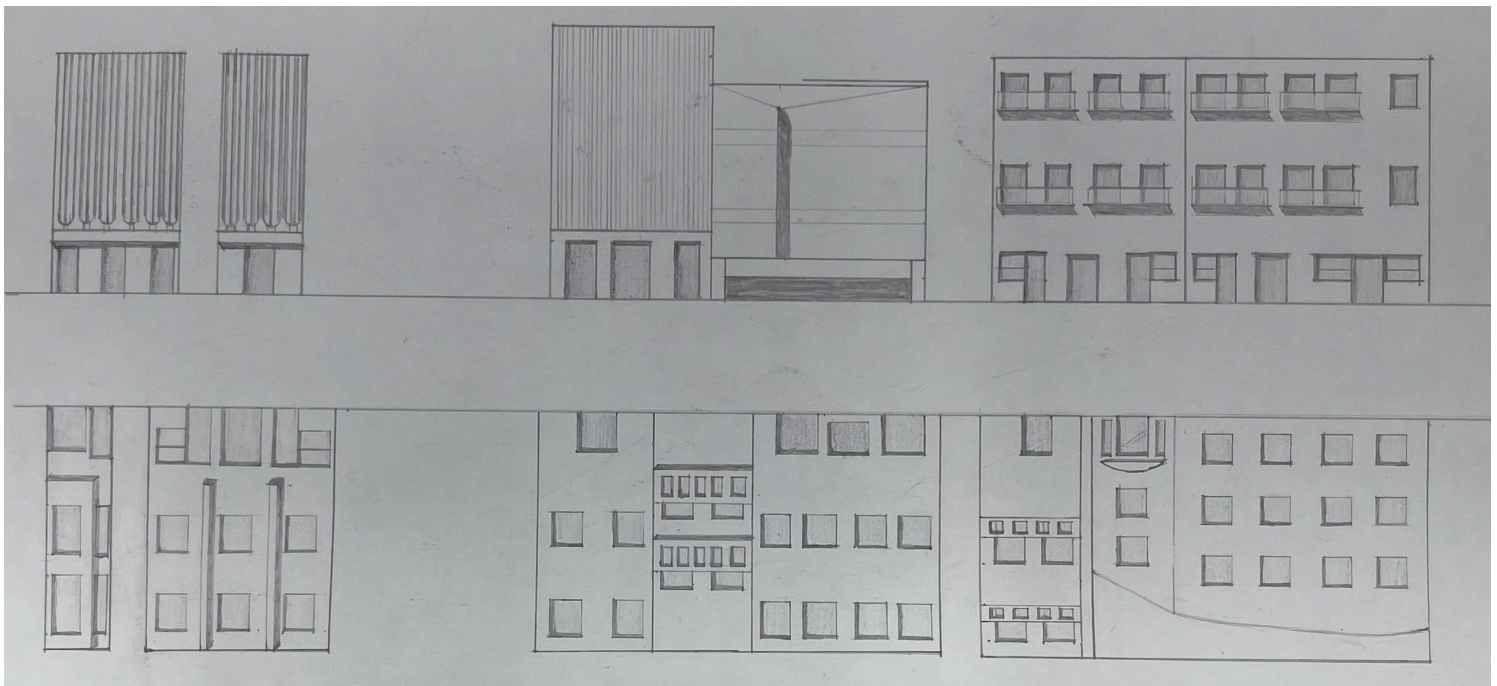






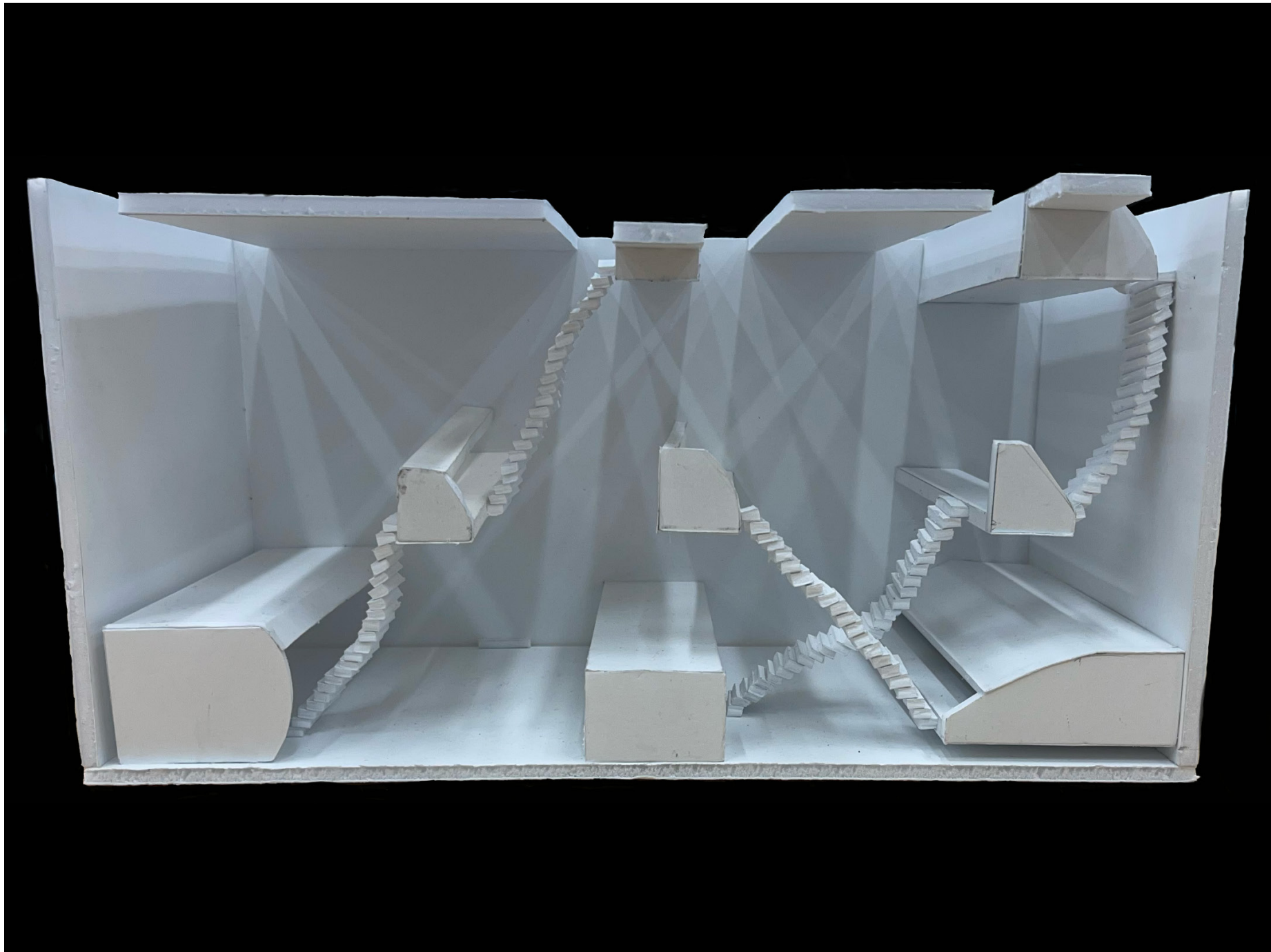


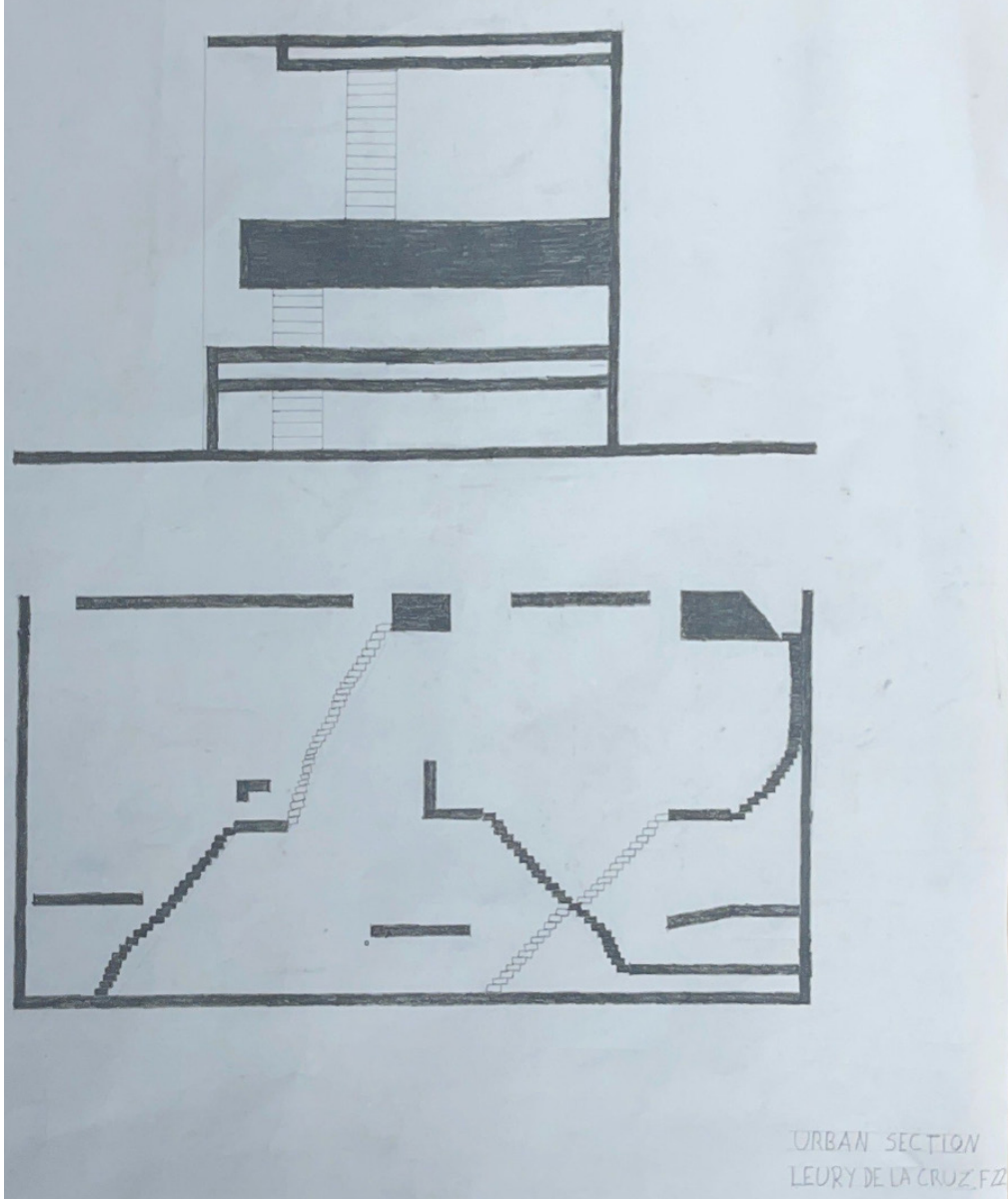




# 06 Urban Section
