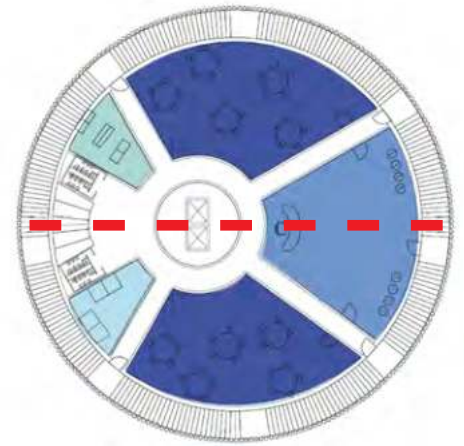




THIRD FLOOR PLAN



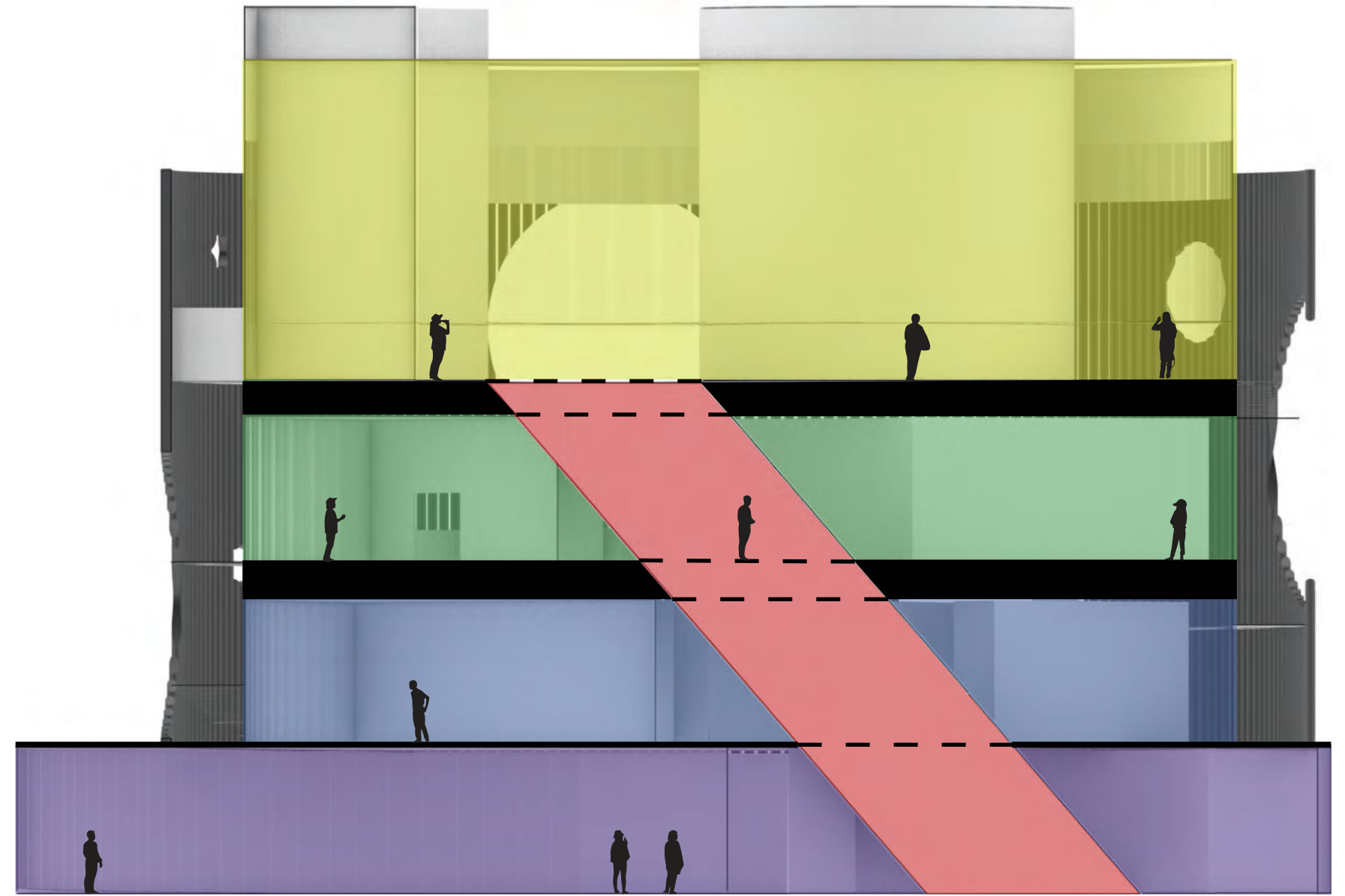
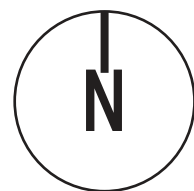

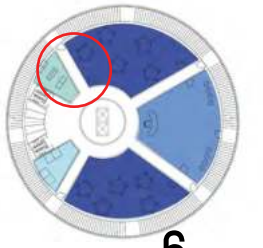


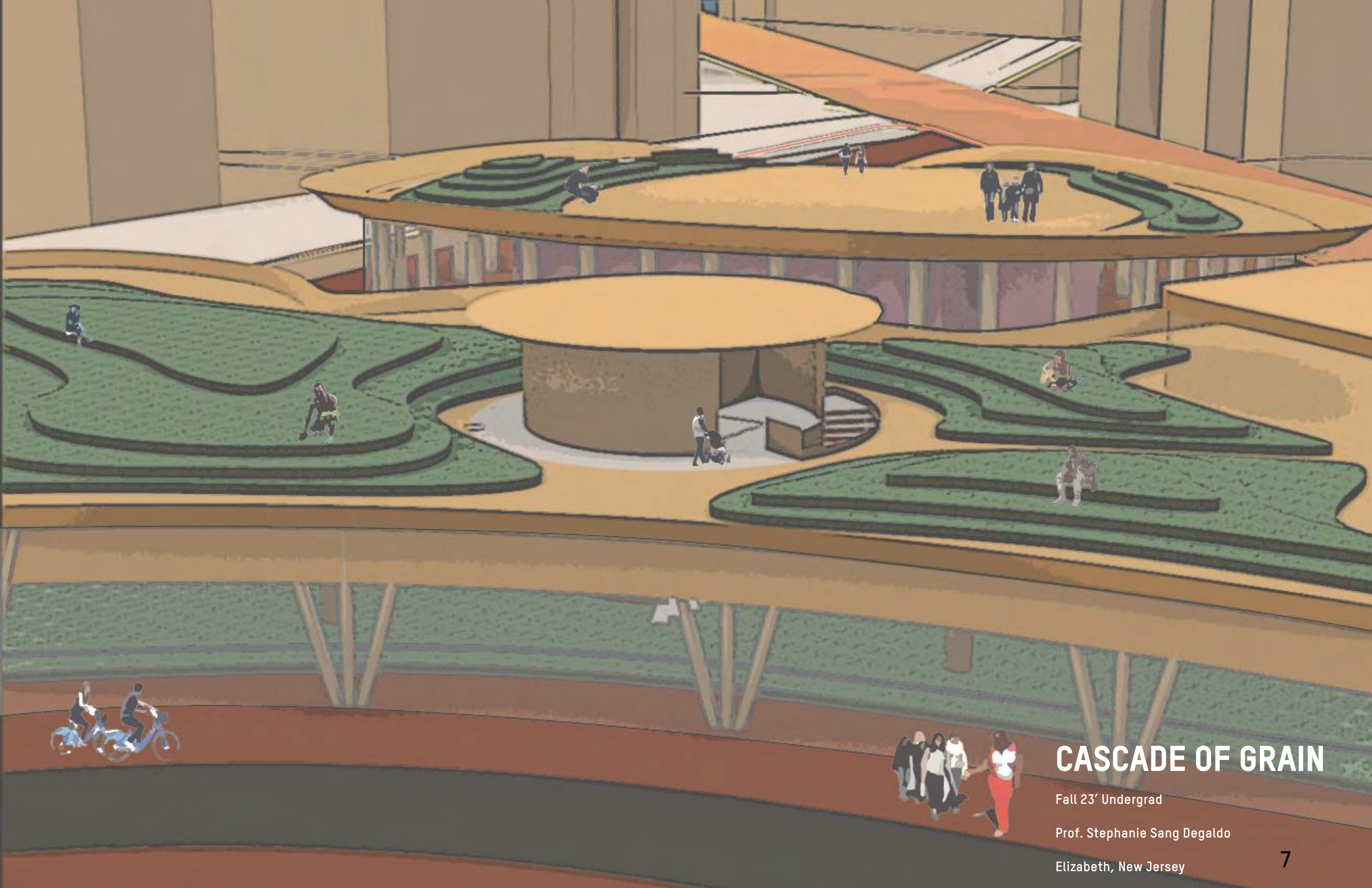


INTERIOR VIEW SECOND FLOOR

### TPD Director Wilson Corrects Record on Crime

TRENTON, N.J. – Trenton Police Director Steve Wilson today provided an update on crime throughout the City of Trenton in rebuttal to misinformation propagated by members of City Council during their combined session on Thursday, August 4.

These decades of mistreatment and disregard have served to slowly silence East Trenton's community; as each year passes with little to no change in policy/services, residents lose more and more hope of any sort of progress. This has led to an outsourcing of existing, Trenton-based camps towards meeting areas within the safer zones of Hamilton or Princeton.

The more recent COVID pandemic has led to another issue of an increased stay-at-home workforce, more specifically in the form of chefs. Many stay-at-home chefs have emerged from the pandemic, offering healthier, home cooked alternatives against the ever-lasting presence of fast food services in underprivileged areas. For decades, Trenton has visibly divided itself into East and West sectors along US Route 1. The result of this is a clean, safe Western federal district, with noticeably no limit to any federal spending. The Eastern district, on the other hand, suffers more and more with every passing year. East Trenton inhabits over 75% of the city's population, yet it is one of the most underfunded, underprotected and underserved city districts in all of New Jersey. Of most significance are the great disparities between East Trenton's education system and that of neighboring districts...



"What I notice is we have too many liquor stores and abandon buildings also there are less opprotunites near the city than there is for people in the suburban areas not only mentioning that the kind that keeps us in a loophole to like not grow or like outgrow ourselves"

Trenton, the capital of New Jersey state since 1792, is a small city consisting of approx. 83,000 community members. Today, the city is bisected through US Route 1, which converts into the Garden State Parkway a few miles north of Trenton. On the west of US 1, Trenton mostly consists of municipal office/court buildings; Trenton's east side houses most residential spaces.

While it hasn't yet been appreciated to its fullest extent, the Trenton Transit Center provides GREAT potential for Trenton's growth as a community; The transit center is a focal destination point for the D.C. Capital Connection Bus Route, AMTRAK/SEPTA rail from Pennsylvania, as well as NJTRANSIT.

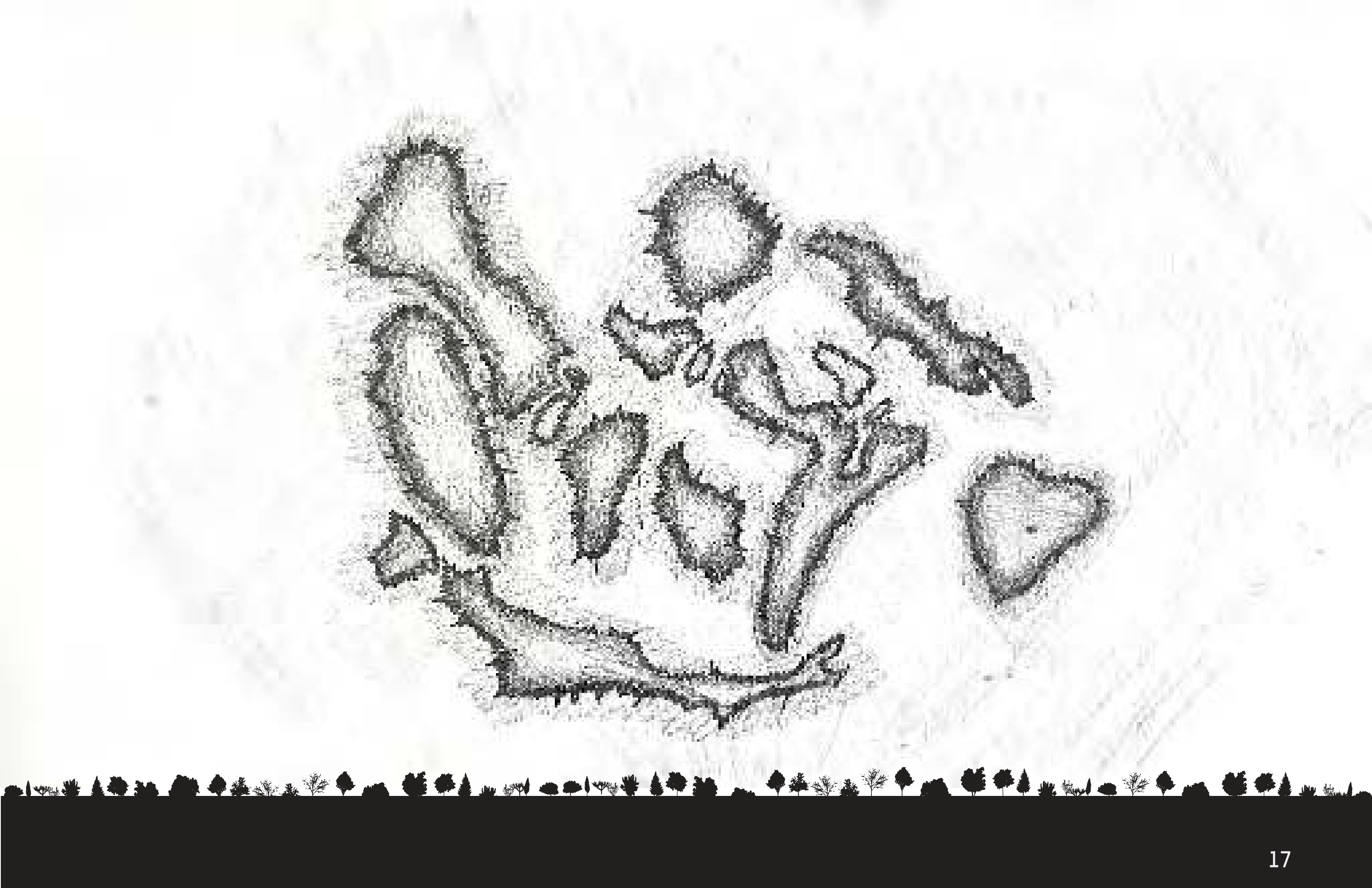

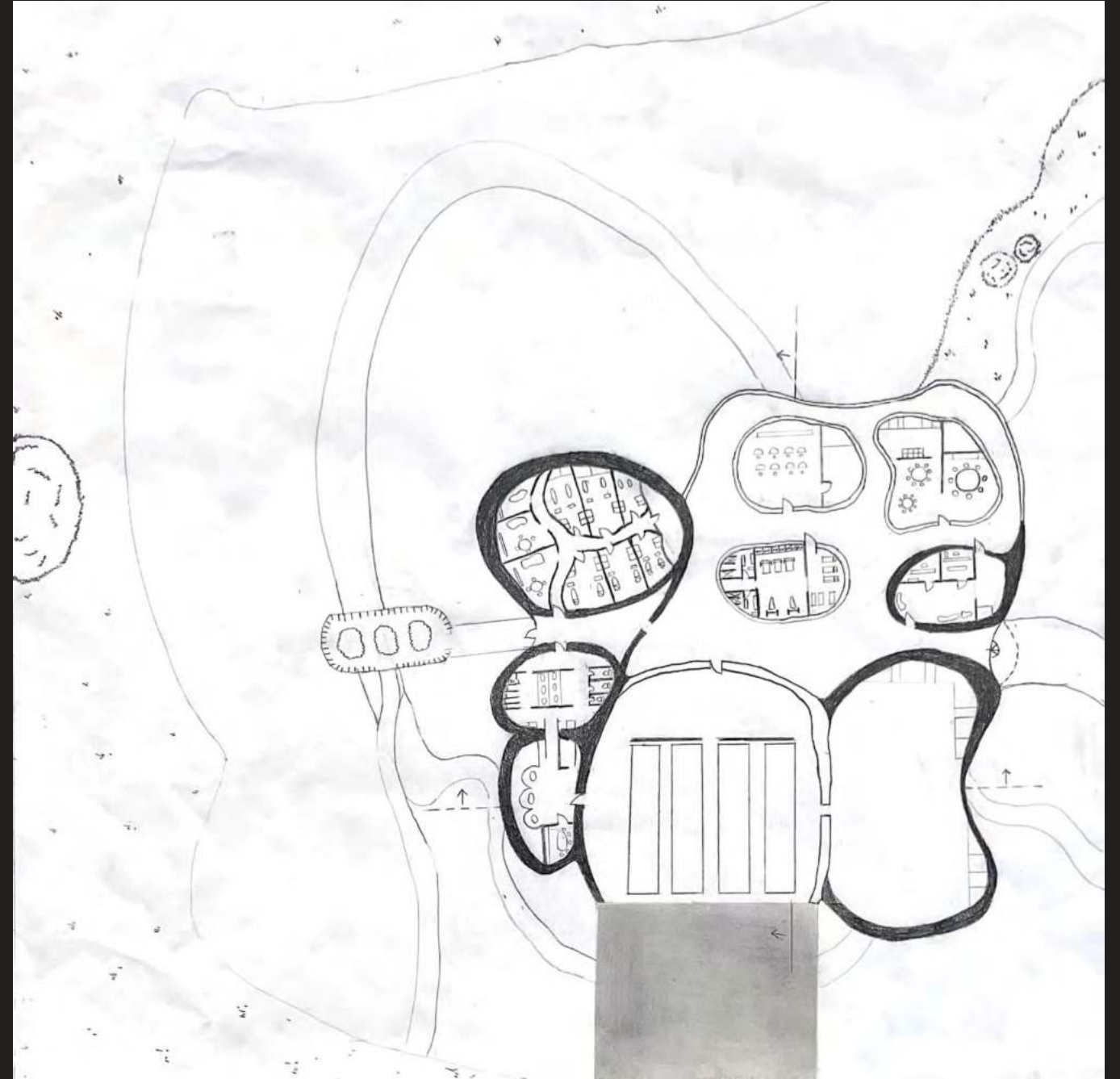

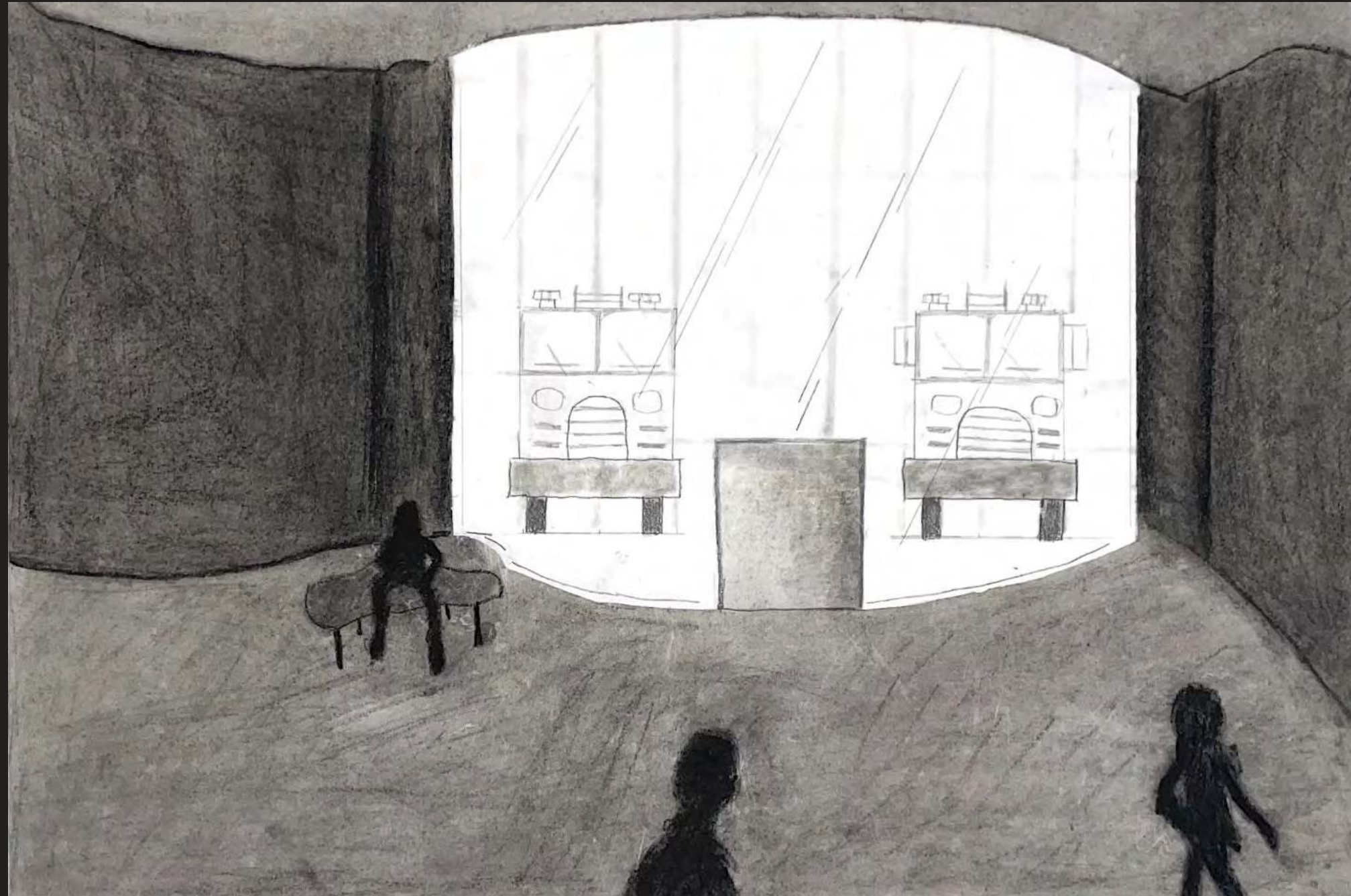
SITE PLAN



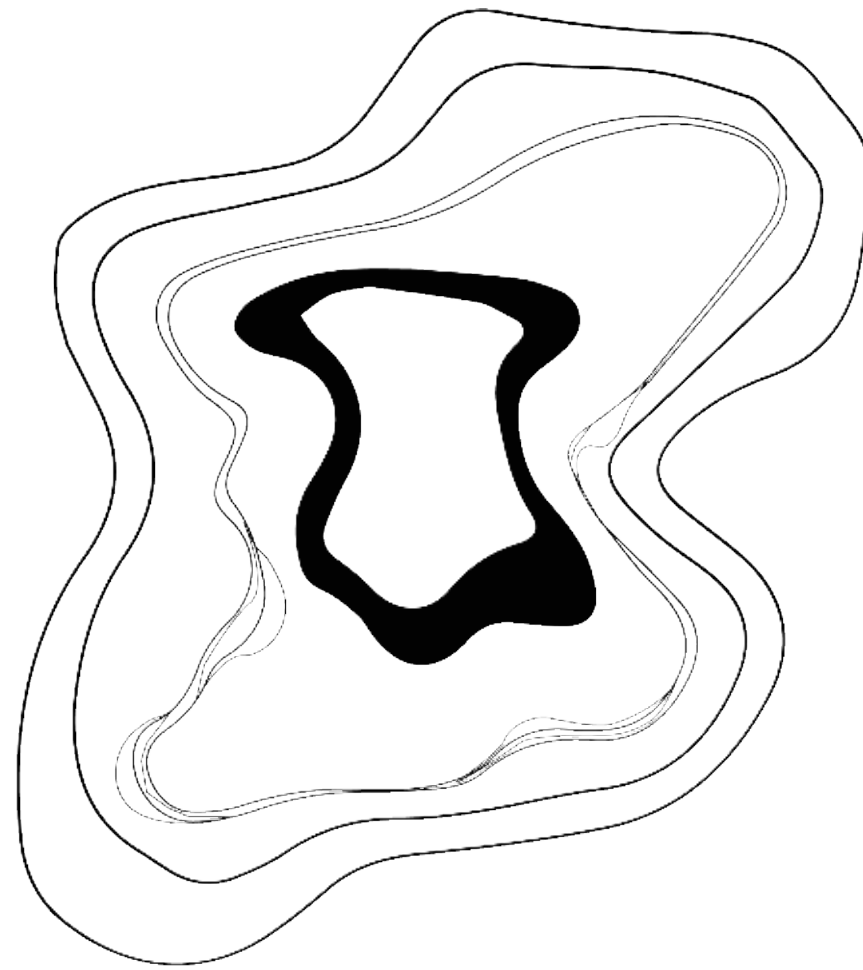
GROUND FLOOR PLAN

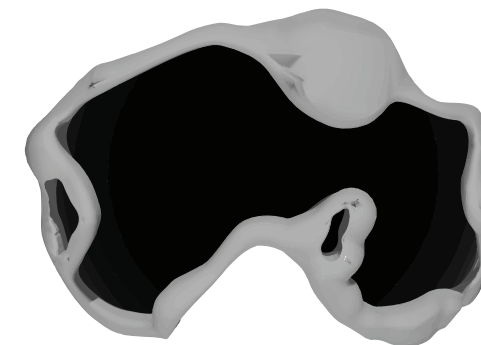
